Numerator

Population 1: Patients 18 and older who were screened for transportation insecurity within the measurement period.

Population 2: Patients 18 and older who received a referral or intervention for transportation insecurity within the measurement period.

Population 3: Patients who were screened for transportation insecurity AND received a referral or intervention.

Denominator

All patients aged 18 years and older seen for at least two outpatient visits during the measurement period.
